  necessary.
- 3. **Grant Narrative**, which provides a detailed outline of the information that should be provided in a project grant application. This narrative section should be completed instead of the narrative questions in the general operating support proposal.

- F. Describe your overall goal(s) for your project and objectives, or ways in which you will meet the goal(s). This plan should be tailored to the CA Learning Foundations (Preschool/TK or Infant/Toddler).
- G. Please describe your criteria for success. Be as clear as you can about the impact you expect to have on children and families. What do you want to happen as a result of your activities? It may be helpful to describe both immediate and long-term outcomes for children and families.
- H. The grant will be requesting both quantitative and qualitative data. Templates and other requirements will be provided. Who will be responsible for completing this requirement? (Optional for Minor Grant)
