



# Eligible Activities for ages 5 to 10

Pregnancy to the day before the child's 11th birthday

Unless otherwise indicated, all documentation of completed activities should be submitted through the activity claim form. Please uncheck the final question on the activity claim form if you do not want your photos to be used to promote the Home Run to other West Sacramento families. **Please note that there is a \$250 limit per age group.**

<b>Volunteer at Your Child's School or Early Learning Site</b>	Volunteer at your child's school or early learning site.	Have your child's teacher/school or site administrator answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo of you volunteering.	\$25 per 10 volunteer hours, maximum of \$50 per year
<b>Special Incentive</b>	Special incentives are offered occasionally, for a limited time. Watch Home Run social media for details. Restrictions may apply.	Required documentation may vary and will be described with the Special Incentive announcement.	Amounts may vary and will be described with the Special Incentive announcement.
<b>Home Run Referral</b>	Refer a friend or family member to enroll in a West Sacramento Home Run program.	Friend or family member provides your name when creating their profile with the Home Run Savings Tracker	\$25 per enrollment, maximum of \$75

<b>Kindergarten Enrollment</b>	Enroll child in transitional kindergarten (T-K) or kindergarten.	Enrollment form from WUSD or other accredited T-K or kindergarten provider	\$25, one time only
<b>Parenting Workshop</b>	Attend a one-time or multi-part parenting workshop.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo verification of attendance.	\$20 per workshop or workshop series, \$60 maximum
<b>Pediatrician or Dental Checkup</b>	Get a prenatal checkup if pregnant or take your child to a pediatric or dental checkup.	Visit summary form provided by the doctor, or photo of your child in the doctor's/dentist's office	\$10 per visit, maximum of one per year
<b>Join the PTO</b>	Join your child's school's parent-teacher organization (PTO).	Proof of PTO membership.	\$20, one time only
<b>ScholarShare Account</b>	Open a <a href="#">ScholarShare 529 college savings account</a> for your child.	Account statement.	\$50, one time only

<b>529 College Savings Account</b>	Open a 529 college savings account for your child from a provider other than ScholarShare (not available for ScholarShare account holders).	Account Statement	\$25, one time only
<b>Link Accounts</b>	Link your child's ScholarShare 529 account to their Ready, Set, Save! Account.	Notify Home Run team - readysavesave@cityofwestsacramento.org	\$50, one time only
<b>CalKids Account</b>	<a href="#">Register your child's CalKids account.</a>	Account Statement	\$50, one time only
<b>Family event</b>	Attend a West Sacramento community event for families and children offered by your school, church, or a community-based organization.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo of participant at the event.	\$20 for each event attended, maximum of \$60
<b>What I want to Be</b>	Complete a "What I Want to Be" Project.	Follow the <a href="#">What I Want to Be Project Guidelines</a> and upload a photo on activity claim form. <a href="#">(Click here for the guidelines in Spanish)</a>	\$10 per project, maximum of \$20
<b>Learning from a Mistake</b>	Complete a "Learning from a mistake" project.	Follow the <a href="#">Learning from a Mistake Project Guidelines</a> and upload a photo on activity claim form. <a href="#">(Click here for the guidelines in Spanish)</a>	\$10 per story, maximum of \$20



<b>Library Card</b>	Obtain a public library card for your child.	Photo of your library card	\$10, one time only
<b>Read a Book</b>	Read a book from the library or your home and submit a response.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo of participant with the book.	\$10 per book response, maximum of \$30
<b>Family Fun</b>	Participate with your family in health or nutrition-related activities such as cooking a healthy meal together, going on a hike, playing sports, bike riding, etc.	Photo of the child and family member(s) doing the activity	\$5 per activity, maximum of \$20
<b>Join a club</b>	Join a club or extracurricular activity at your school and participate for a full school year.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo verification of participation.	\$10 per club, per year
<b>Join a Sports League</b>	Participate in a sports team or league for at least four weeks.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo verification of participation.	\$10 per league or team, per year
<b>Summer STEAM Enrichment</b>	Participate in a summer enrichment program with a focus on science, technology, engineering, the arts or math (STEAM) that is at least two weeks long	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo verification of participation.	\$15 per program, per year



<b>After-school STEAM Activities</b>	Participate in a STEAM focused after-school enrichment program.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo verification of participation.	\$15 per program, per year
<b>After-school Activities</b>	Participate in a non-STEAM after-school enrichment program.	Answer the questions on the activity claim form and upload photo verification of participation.	\$10 per program, per year
<b>Perfect Attendance</b>	Attend school for one academic year with zero or very few unexcused absences.	Official attendance record for one full school year	0 unexcused absences: \$100; 1- 3 absences: \$75; 4- 7 absences: \$50. \$200 lifetime maximum.
